

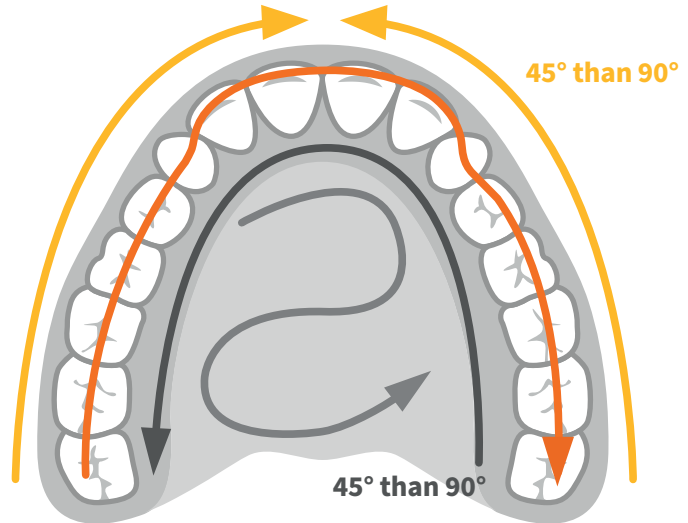
Scanning Strategy Tips

- Moving tissue is the issue:
Retract the lips, cheeks and tongue for a better the experience.
- First path (Occlusal) is Key:
spend a sec per tooth.
- To be exact, keep the scanner in contact.
- Constant and steady makes you happy.

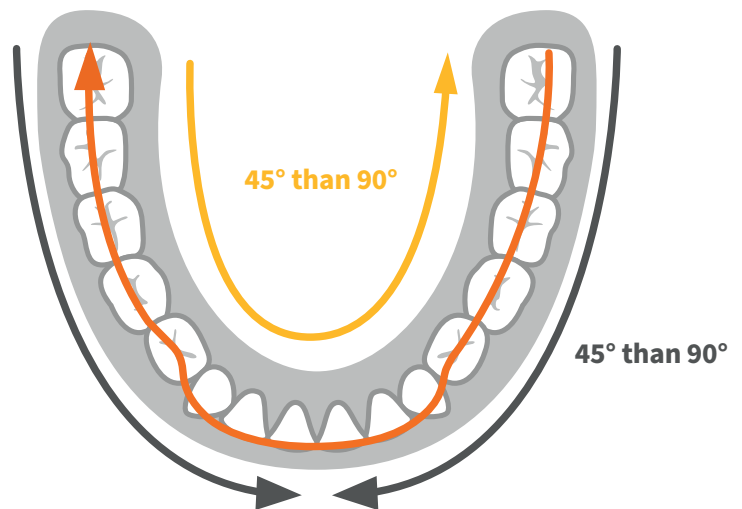
Extra Tips:

- For Maxillary: rotate the tip so it's facing up
- When scanning the **Buccal** side: First start scanning with a **45° angle** then rescan with an **90° angle**.
- To properly fill the holes, angle the scanner in different direction.

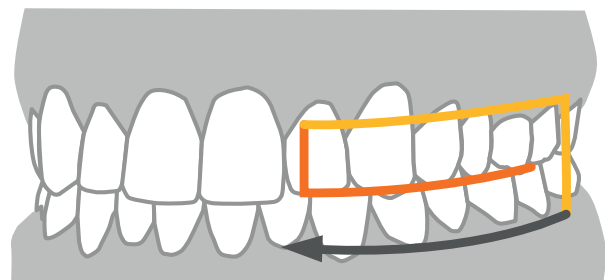
1. Occlusal 2. Buccal 3. Palatal
